A. Essay

Write an essay (500 words minimum) describing what motivates you to participate in JRLA for 2020-2021? Please describe your interest in the James River and the environment. What excites you most about the JRLA? How will completing the JRLA program contribute to your personal, academic, or career goals? Why should you be chosen to participate in the JRLA?

- **B. Short Answers** (1 paragraph minimum for each question)
 - **1.**What do you think are some of the most important qualities for someone to excel in the JRLA? Which of these qualities could you bring to this unique program? Describe specifically how your motivation to be involved will positively impact other JRLA students as a team.
 - **2**. Some JRLA Leadership Sessions will involve challenging activities, including remaining openminded during discussions, thinking critically, problem solving, and learning skills previously unknown to you. Describe the biggest challenge you have faced in the past year, how you were able to manage the situation, and the outcome. Describe what you learned from this experience.
 - **3**. Describe the current or past long-term commitments you have made, if any (sports teams, local organizations, service groups, etc.) How will you make sure that you maintain your commitment to the JRLA in addition to your other responsibilities?
 - **4**. JRLA will require strong teamwork to address environmental issues and make a positive impact through community-based action projects. Share you most memorial volunteer experience? Describe a time when you worked with others to complete a task and how your role and efforts contributed to its success.
 - **5**. JRLA will occasionally require physical activity in a wilderness setting, including paddling, camping, hiking, and moving equipment. Instruction for these activities will be provided. Please briefly describe any physical or medical conditions that may limit you from completing these tasks safely (for example: sports injury, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy, etc.)

C. Teacher Recommendation and Personal Recommendation

Please submit two positive letters of recommendation from one of your current teachers and one unrelated adult you know personally. Please share all of the JRLA information with these adults, and attach his/her **recommendation and signature** to your application.
